**Important event to report: The positive opinion of the European Commission on the project of Units 3 and 4 at CNE Cernavodă**

Nuclearelectrica announces the adoption of the positive opinion of the European Commission on the project of Units 3 and 4 at CNE Cernavodă, on the basis of Article 41 of the Euratom Treaty. The project is managed by the project company Energonuclear, wholly owned by Societatea Națională Nuclearelectrica SA (SNN).

The viewpoint submitted on July 1, 2024 reflects the assessment by the European Commission - Directorate General for Energy, of the technical and nuclear safety aspects of the project. Under the Euratom Treaty, nuclear project developers are required to notify the European Commission of planned investments and to demonstrate compliance with the highest nuclear safety standards. Energonuclear notified the Commission about the Units 3 and 4 project in May 2023.

The opinion received is the result of an elaborate analysis of the information provided by the Romanian side, site visits to the CNE Cernavodă site and technical discussions over a period of 13 months. The Commission's assessment is that the project to complete the construction of Units 3 and 4 at CNE Cernavodă is in line with the objectives of the Euratom Treaty.

This positive view is accompanied by the usual recommendations for such projects, which aim at the appropriate application of the Euratom framework in the implementation and during the lifetime of the project. These recommendations will be implemented by the project developer in the next steps.

With 4 nuclear units in operation in Romania, it is expected to avoid the emission of 20 million tons of CO<sub>2</sub> per year and to create more than 19,000 jobs in the horizontal industry.
